

Dear 3rd Grade Families,

If you would like your 3rd grader to extend their practice at home, here are our suggestions for home study.

-Read 20 minutes each night. Your child can record their reading on the reading log below. When they finish a book, your child can complete one of the book reports below.

-Practice spelling words. Spelling words for the next several weeks and a list of ideas for fun ways to practice spelling words can be found below.

-For math practice, we recommend having your child use either iReady or Khan Academy. These two programs adapt to your child's level, so they will be getting individualized practice.
